**Job Overview**

Wake Coaches are responsible for leading wakeboarding and wakesurfing camps, lessons, and classes. - Talk to parents before and after sessions to update them on their riders progress
- Film riders to give them video feedback for improvement
- Work closely with boat driver to maintain a safe efficient environment
- Maintain the cleanliness of JSAW's boat
- As needed support/mentor 2-3 riders in the disciple making process
